Within this download you will find the items listed below in the glossary. Please feel free to use these however required. All download rooms are grouped to maintain current HTM and HBN standards (at the time of download only). These standards do change and buyers therefore need to be careful about forming their own libraries.

Glossary of Terms

Room Data Sheets (RDS) give a detailed description of all the finishes, fixtures and fittings, mechanical and electrical requirements that will be required for each room or space in a project or build.

Room data sheets are used to communicate the client's requirements for each room on a project. They can be provided to a design team by room types or define the requirements for each room. They may include requirements and guidance notes to help ensure the correct choices are made from the outset. They should be further developed by design teams to include actual specifications.

They include information about the room including its name, number, location, and use and then detailed descriptions of all the finishes, fixtures and fittings, mechanical and electrical requirements within the space.

C-Sheets are used to define the detail of each individual room or clinical space during the Healthcare Space Planning process. The C-Sheets show elevations and plan views of the planned equipment ready for installation on site (as detailed in **RDS**). These evolve over time and change from generic plans and elevations to fully specified sheets for construction.

ROOMS come complete with structural elements (Revit System Families). In essence a Room is a 3 dimensional C sheet and will come complete with 2D C-sheets.
